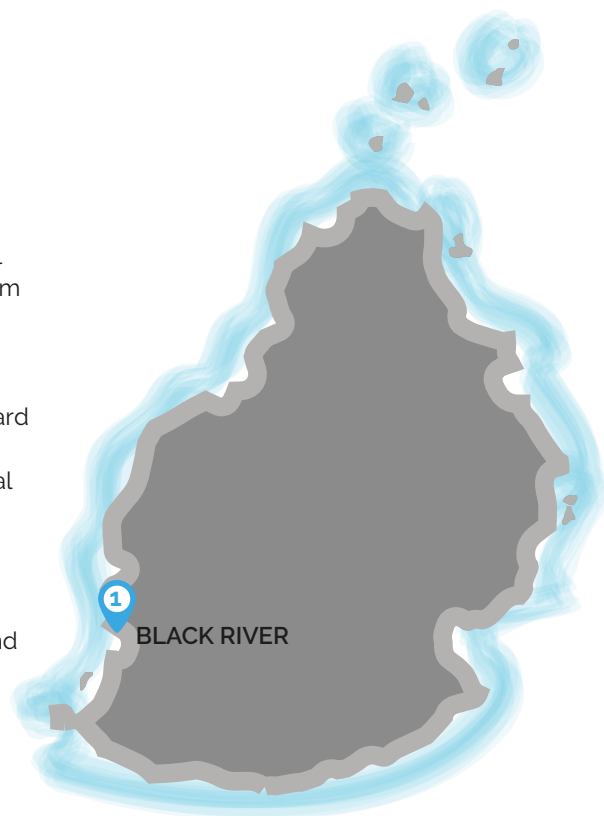
THE JOURNEY

ITINERARY

Day 6 – Departure: let the adventure begin

Your journey kicks off with an international flight to Mauritius, a sparkling gem in the Indian Ocean, where unforgettable encounters with wild sperm whales await.

Day 7 – Arrival in Mauritius & Beachfront Hotel Stay

Welcome to Mauritius! You'll be greeted at the international airport and taken by private transfer to the charming La Mariposa boutique hotel, set right on the sands of La Preneuse. It's the perfect spot to unwind and soak in the beauty of nature. Enjoy a relaxed afternoon with ocean views.

Day 8 – First Encounter with the Sperm Whales

Our first outing at sea runs from 11:00 AM to 3:00 PM. The adventure kicks off as we set out in search of sperm whales, equipped with snorkel gear and snacks on board. This is an ethical experience led by experts who always put respect for marine life first.

Day 9 – Snorkeling the Indian Ocean

Our second day of exploration begins. We board the boat again at 11:00 AM for another chance to swim alongside these ocean giants. Afterward, return to the hotel for a relaxing afternoon to share stories and unwind.

Day 10 – Pure Marine Adventure

The third snorkeling trip with sperm whales awaits—always accompanied by a professional guide, with all equipment and refreshments provided. Mauritius' rich biodiversity ensures each excursion is different: you might spot not just sperm whales, but also dolphins, turtles, or seabirds.

Day 11 – Beyond Snorkeling: Deep Connection with Nature

The fourth sea adventure runs once again from 11:00 AM to 3:00 PM. This is the perfect day to observe sperm whales in a calm, unhurried setting—whether in the water or from the boat. Expect a truly profound and transformative experience.

APNEA SESSIONS

- Daily sessions focused on improving lung, diaphragm, and overall respiratory flexibility
- Relaxation and breathing practice sessions
- Frenzel equalization session
- Deep equalization session (Mouthfill)
- Theory sessions (Physiology, Safety, Rescue, Risks, and finning biomechanics)
- Advanced Freediving Theory session (training tables, exhale dives, tents, and extending time at depth)
- Static Apnea sessions in the pool + watsu





ABOUT THE TRIP

DEPARTURE RECOMMENDATIONS

- We recommend completing online check-in, available 48 hours before your flight.
- Please arrive at the airport at least 2 hours and 30 minutes before your departure.
- Departure terminals: Please check with your airline and departure city.
- Carry-on luggage: One small suitcase. Check with your airline for maximum weight limits.
- Checked luggage: Up to 23 kg. Confirm the maximum weight allowed with your airline.
- Liquids in carry-ons: Maximum 100 ml each.

AIRPORT-HOTEL-AIRPORT TRANSFERS

- **DAY 6:** Transfer from Mauritius Airport to Hotel Mariposa is scheduled for approximately 1:00 PM.
- **DAY 15:** Transfer from the hotel back to the airport is scheduled for around 3:00 PM.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION

- **Required Documents:** Make sure to bring your passport (expiration date must be more than 6 months away).
- **Payments:** Extra charges can be paid in €, \$, local currency, or by credit card (additional fees may apply). Mauritian Rupee: 1€ = 50 Rupees.
- **Weather in Mauritius:** The outside temperature usually ranges from a high of 29°C to a low of 20°C. Water temperature is typically between 25–26°C.
- **Suggested Clothing:** Short-sleeve shirts, swimwear, and shorts are recommended. It's also a good idea to bring a pair of long pants and a sweatshirt or sweater for the evenings.

- **Snorkeling gear needed:** 3 mm wetsuit or swimwear, fins, mask, and snorkel.

- **Outlets:** Type C and G



- **Body wash and shampoo:** Provided in every room, but we recommend bringing your own.

REQUIREMENTS FOR TRAVELING TO MAURITIUS

- Passport (must be valid for at least 6 months from your arrival date).
- Before traveling to Mauritius, it's recommended to complete the "Mauritius All in One travel form" online. This will generate a PDF with a QR code. Print a copy and have it ready to show Health officials upon arrival at the airport. If you don't have a printed copy, you'll need to fill out an Immigration Disembarkation Card upon arrival.
- Be sure to have digital or printed copies of your flight information, travel invoice, and this form.
